Overview:

Supervises Tubing Park and staff. Tubing Supervisor is in charge of above stated area and ensures that all employees adhere to all company rules. Ensures that Tubing Attendants maintain the loading and unloading areas, performs crowd control, checks tubing tickets and season passes. This is an outside job working in a variety of winter weather elements. The Tubing Supervisor ensures that the daily operation of the Tubing Park is done in a safe and efficient manner while promoting positive guest relations with riders and staff.

Job Description:

The supervisor will delegate, monitor and be responsible for:

- Loading and unloading customers on and off the tubes.
- Shoveling and removing snow; maintaining ramp and waiting areas.
- Providing information to customers.
- · Assisting guests loading onto the chair lift.
- · Checking tickets and passes.
- Handling crowd control in lift queue areas.
- Monitoring the safety of guests in the tubing lanes and unload area.
- Creating weekly work schedules for tubing park staff
- Coordinating relief and lunch breaks for attendants
- Completing all daily lift paperwork.
- Ensuring that equipment is safe and reports to Director anything that is unsafe or broken.

Must be able to stand for extended periods, shovel snow and maintain load and unload areas in the Tubing Park.
